The Village Information Centre

The Village Information Centre is an independent charitable organisation operating under a local trust, The Rural Community Support Society. It began life as a community service initiative by members of Herstmonceux Free Church in 1998.

In 2003 the present Trust was set up and today the Centre stands on its own two feet, still serving the community, responding to needs and forging links between service providers and people in the local rural community.

We were fortunate to have had a benefactor in Peter Sangster who bought the building and left it with us in Trust for the benefit of the community run by the community.

The centre now plays a different role still run by volunteers we are open weekday mornings offering, use of the computer, printing, Photostatting, bus time tables and brochures Hearing aid batteries are available on the 2nd and 4th Friday of the month. If information is not to hand we will endeavour to find it. There is also a large window for the display of posters and leaflets of forthcoming events There is no charge for community events and charity organisations but a small fee applies to businesses. However we will not display party political posters as we are non political with no affiliation to anyone

There is a meeting room which is used by groups such as Knit and Stitch, the Allotment Association and Herstmonceux walking group. The room is free subject

to availability and approval for non profit making organisations serving the community with the parish of Herstmonceux. We also have a small kitchen that can be made available.
